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Thomas Dozol was born in Martinique and educated in Paris. After receiving a masters in Economics and Social Studies, he veered into the performing arts.

In 2002, he moved to New York as a stage actor and became involved with the cabaret act, *The Citizens Band*. Rather than performing, however, he chose to document their rehearsals and their premier performance at Deitch Projects. The resulting portfolio received international attention, successfully launching him as a photographer.

His work has been featured in *Interview*, *Vogue Paris*, *Another Man*, *Apartamento* and *Pin-Up*, among others. In 2004, he founded One Wall Gallery, an itinerant and ephemeral gallery concept, whose last instalment presented photographs by Helena Christensen at Colette in Paris. His first solo show, *I'll Be Your Mirror*, was shown in New York and Sao Paulo. In 2011, he presented his second solo show in New York, *All Together Now*. The artist showed a new body of work, experimenting with silkscreen printing, at Jack Hanley Gallery (New York, NY) this Fall. Dozol lives and works in New York City.
